The African continent is poised for growth given the policies and reforms that have been implemented in recent years. Current policies and agreements promise significant gains, including economic diversification, structural transformation, technological development and job creation. Forecasts with regards to the new policies and reforms predict \$1,2 billion consumer market spend for African businesses and \$4 trillion in estimated private and business to business spend along with 13 million to 16 million new jobs. The World Bank predicts that by 2035 the volume of total exports of manufactured goods will increase by 29%, whilst intra-Africa manufacturing trade climbs to 110% and manufacturing exports to the rest of the world rise 46%.

Tech-Access Rwanda will showcase Rwandan businesses in the technology sector looking for growth across borders and internationally. The engagement and interaction with African and International investors and partners will provide a business platform for funding, access to markets and mentorships that will ensure future success & sustainability for these established businesses.

WHY RWANDA?

Rwanda continues to be one of the fastest growing African countries in ICT and there are several avenues for growth for the ICT sector – from e-commerce and e-services, mobile technologies, applications development and automation to becoming a regional center for the training of top quality ICT professionals and research. A robust ICT industry can create wealth, jobs and entrepreneurs.

The Information and Communication Technology grew by 29% in 2020. ICT sector was one of the few sectors that registered a positive trend in the past year, owing to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at current market prices of ICT activities was estimated to be \$2,2mil compared to \$1.8mil in the previous year. Rwanda's telecommunication firms are expecting 20% (year on year) growth in revenue driven by demand of services in 2020.
